



# Wisdom Cowl

## Skill Level

Easy

## Finished Measurements

24.5 inches in circumference x 7.5 inches in height

## Materials

Wisdom Yarns Poems (worsted) weight 100% wool yarn (1.75 oz/109 yds/50g per ball):

2 balls #591 Vesuvius

Size I/9/5.5mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge

Tapestry needle

## Gauge

18 sc, ch 1 pairs + 1 ch 1 x 22 rnds = 4 inches in Linen Stitch

## Pattern Stitch

Linen Stitch (multiple of 2 sts)

**Rnd 1:** \*sc, ch 1, rep from \* to form pat.

**Rnd 2:** \*ch1, sc in ch-1 sp from previous row, rep rom \* to form pat. Rep **Rnd 2** for pat.

## Pattern Notes

This is a super simple cowl worked in a continuous spiral from the bottom up using the linen stitch.

I rewound the second ball so that the colors in the middle matched up and then reversed to the top.

Forgive me if something about these simple instructions seem out of whack. I am more of a knitter than crocheter.

## Cowl

**Rnd 1:** Ch 112, join for working in the rnd using a sl st. \*sc, ch1, rep from \* around.

**Rnd 2:** \*Ch 1, sc in ch-1 sp in previous round, rep from \* around.

Basically rep Rnd 2 until you run out of yarn.

## Finishing

Weave in ends. Block if you wish.

<b>ch</b>	chain
<b>ch-1 sp</b>	space created by ch 1 in previous row
<b>g</b>	grams
<b>oz</b>	ounces
<b>pat</b>	pattern
<b>rep</b>	repeat
<b>rnd(s)</b>	Round(s)
<b>sc</b>	single
crochet	
<b>sl st</b>	slip stitch
<b>yds</b>	yards



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
