

# cache cou doux



## MATERIALS

### BISCOTTE YARNS

- Albus (100g) shown in color Vanille
- Hermione (20g) shown in Limited Edition

### CIRCULAR NEEDLES

- Needles of 6mm – US#10

### ACCESSORIES

- Stitch Marker (1)
- Cable needle
- Tapestry needle

**GAUGE** : 16 stitches = 10 cm – 4 inches, in garter stitch with yarn held doubled (Albus & Hermione).

**COWL CIRCUMFERENCE** : 40 cm (16 inches)

## NOTES

First rows of the cowl are worked back and forth and when you are ready to work in the round, the last stitches of the rows are knit together with the first stitch of the row/round.

## GARTER STITCH BEGINNING

With yarn held doubled, cast-on loosely 96 stitches (do not join in the round yet).

**Row 1 (RS)** : k3, [p2, k2] x 22, p2, k3.

**Row 2 (WS)**: k3, [k2, p2] x 22, k5.

Work the last 2 rows 9 more times for a total of 20 rows.

## START TO WORK IN THE ROUND

**TRANSITION on RS**, k3, [p2, k2] x 21, p2, slip the last 7 sts on cable needle and join to work in the round, holding the cable needle in the FRONT of the work.

**Knit the 7 sts from the cable needle WITH the first 7 sts of the round as follow** : insert right needle in the first st from cable needle AND first st of the round and knit them together; repeat for the next st. Insert right needle as if to purl into the next st from the round AND next st from cable needle and purl them together; knit the last 3 sts together just as you did for the first 2 sts.

**WORK IN THE ROUND UNTIL THE END**, place a marker to identify the beginning of rounds and work the following two rounds:

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**Round 1** : [p2, k2] x 21, p5, slip marker.

**Round 2** : [p2, k2] x 21, p2, k3, slip marker.

Work the last 2 rounds 16 more times (for a total of 34 rounds).

**Bind-off loosely and weave-in the ends.**

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## ABBREVIATIONS

**K**: knit

**P** : purl

**RS**: right side

**St(s)**: stitch(es)

**WS**: wrong side
